





Review 1:

If you are puzzled by some of St. Paul's teaching about the role of women in the church, this book is a big help. The authors have studied the religions, cultures, and false teachings of the times and shed light on what Paul wrote in light of those issues.

The book attempts to persuade readers that the author of 1 Timothy (which they don't believe is Paul, pp.44-46) prohibited women from teaching and having authority over men simply because of false teachings in Ephesus. Below are 3 scholars discrediting Kroegers' work.

- 1. Stephen Baugh, a New Testament professor at Westminster Seminary (California) wrote his Ph.D. thesis on the history of ancient Ephesus, writes in his review, "...the Kroegers... have painted a picture of Ephesus which wanders widely from the facts." He also writes, "It is difficult to imagine how such a momentous conclusion could have been erected upon such fragile, tottering evidence."
- 2. Albert Wolters, an emeritus professor of religion at Redeemer University College in Ancaster, Ontario, writes, "their proposal, both philologically and historically, is a signal failure. In fact, it is not too much to say that their book is precisely the sort of thing that has too often given evangelical scholarship a bad name. There is little in the book's main thesis that can withstand serious scrutiny, and there is a host of subordinate detail that is misleading or downright false."
- 3. Robert W. Yarbrough, Professor of New Testament at Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis, writes, "the book's general method...is to build on one-sided statements, ignoring any research findings or even primary data that do not agree with its thesis. This makes for a convincing presentation, but only so long as one remains ignorant of the full range of pertinent data and dissenting scholarly opinion."

Well researched, fairly scholarly, and certainly not light reading. The latter part can leave your head spinning at times, so not for the faint of heart.

Review 5:

This book is carefully researched and very well documented. It not only resolves questions about 1 Timothy 2:11-15, it also offers important information in understanding the culture and indigenous, Greek/Roman, and Jewish religious views of Asia Minor during the fist century. It is

very helpful in understanding other Biblical writings such as Ephesians, Colossians, and Revelation, to name a few, which are directed toward the churches in Asia Minor. It also gives a good deal of information about goddess worship and the development of Gnosticism in the whole Mediterranean area. The author gives a very satisfying answer to the passage addressed in 1 Timothy which seems to be in contradiction to other Scripture and early Christian church practice. The authors of this book have produced a credible, scholarly, well-written book on a subject of great importance today.
